Option Choices
Year 12 (2019)



This year, all 2019 option choices will be submitted online through the Student Portal accessed through our website. Please refer to the online 2019 Curriculum booklet. An online version is available through the link on the Homepage of the College website. On the reverse side of this sheet, is a list of the various subjects that are proposed during the 2019 academic year.

Online Process

1. Go to the College website www.sanctamaria.school.nz
2. Scroll down the menu on the right hand side to 'Quick Links'
3. Click on 'Parent Portal'
4. A login box will now ask for your username and a password. Once logged in, you will arrive at your learner page. Down the left hand column, click on 'Course Selection'. This will let you now choose your 2019 subjects.
5. For Year 12 students, 12RED, 12PED are compulsory subjects. English is also compulsory but you will need to indicate which course is preferable – 12ENG, 12ENA, 12EAP (English for academic purposes) or 11EAP (English for academic purposes). See the Curriculum Handbook for more information. This leaves 4 subject choices to be decided. You will be asked to confirm your English course and 4 other option choices for next year. For each option choice, scroll through the list of available subjects (with the code – see reverse of sheet) and click your choice.
6. Once you have completed your English choice and the 4 other options choices, then please click 'SAVE'. It will not save if you do not complete all 5 choice boxes.
7. If you have any concerns or issues around your choice of subjects for 2019, please see Mrs Heffernan, Deputy Principal for Curriculum as soon as possible.
8. If you will not be at Sancta Maria College next year or there is a possibility that you might not be returning in 2019, please see Mrs Heffernan to signal your intentions.
9. If you change your mind about an option choice for next year, you will be able to log on again and make changes during this initial online process. It is important to press SAVE again, if you make changes. This window of opportunity will be open will open on Monday 10 September and close at the end of the day on Monday 24 September.
10. There will be a different process for a late change of an option subject involving discussions with yourself, parents, key staff, Mrs Rogers (Careers) and Mrs Heffernan.
