Dear Parents and Caregivers

Most of you will by now be aware that there are three positive COVID-19 cases in Auckland. This means as of 11.59pm tonight, Sunday, 14 February, Auckland will move to Alert Level 3 until at least midnight Wednesday, 17 February. Under Alert Level 3, schools will be closed and we ask parents to keep their children at home from school. However, there will be provision for students in Years 7-10 whose parents are essential workers if no alternative care arrangements can be made. A reminder that at level three you are able to extend your bubble to include a child carer.

If you are an essential worker and would like your child to attend school between 8.30am and 3.15pm Monday – Wednesday you must enrol your child to attend by emailing Courtenay Kilpatrick, Deputy Principal Year 7-10: c.kilpatrick@sanctamaria.school.nz. Please include your child's full name and year level and your essential role. This information will help us to establish safe in school bubbles to support the families of essential workers.

We ask that on Monday, students continue with their in-class work or revising work covered in class over the last week. Work for Tuesday and Wednesday will be placed on Schoology. Conferences will not resume unless the restrictions are extended.
