Sancta Maria College is an integrated Co-educational Catholic College and its practices, beliefs and values are Catholic and guide the work of the College.

Rationale

Sancta Maria College Board of Trustees, as a signatory to the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice will adhere to, and uphold the regulations pertaining to the pastoral care and support of international fee-paying students at the college

Purpose

- To develop cultural understanding and insight in Sancta Maria College students to enable them to become global citizens.
- To foster international cooperation and relationships now and in the future.
- To enable exchanges of benefit to language learners, and other learning and co-curricular areas such as history, geography, social studies, economics, sports, cultural activities, etcetera.
- International Students will benefit by being educated holistically in a safe and nurturing environment that will strongly support their individual learning needs.
- To provide the school with additional funds to enhance quality teaching and learning.

Guidelines

- Provisions for international students according to The Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice will be adhered to and students will receive a high level of pastoral care and academic support;
- 2. Enrolment procedures for international students must be clear and transparent to both provider and client and be regulated according to the Code;
- 3. The school will provide appropriate programmes to meet the individual, learning and social needs of the international fee-paying students by:
 - Providing an orientation programme to support the acculturation of international students into the school and wider community;
 - Providing effective pastoral care and support with appropriate professional development of teaching and ancillary staff;
 - Providing appropriate and effective ESOL programmes to assist the students in learning English to support them in achieving their academic goals across the curriculum;
 - Employ trained, qualified and registered staff to teach the ESOL programmes to ensure a consistently high standard of teaching and assistance is offered.
- 4. The Board of Trustees will ensure that:
 - Fees for international fee-paying students are reviewed annually;
 - International fee-paying students directly benefit from the revenue generated by their enrolment and surpluses are used to improve school wide facilities and resources;
 - An Operating and Marketing Plan for enrolling international students is budgeted for and employed annually;
 - There is a transparent and fair policy regarding the refund of international student fees

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- Sancta Maria College International Department annually reviews information provided to prospective international students, parents, agents, homestay families, designated caregivers to ensure its accuracy and relevancy.
- There will be clear procedures in place which relate to this policy.
